Transformation House- Fridley	351 74th Ave NE Fridley, MN 55432	763-427-7155	Transitional housing for single women and men with chemical dependency issues. Usually 90 day program. Sober environment. Individual or case referrals accepted.

Must have a set income and be in school or working full-time or part-time. Call for an appointment, will initially screen over the phone. Must have 3 months sobriety. Must be 18 yrs or older with minor children, 30% or less than median income level. Can stay up to 2 yrs.
